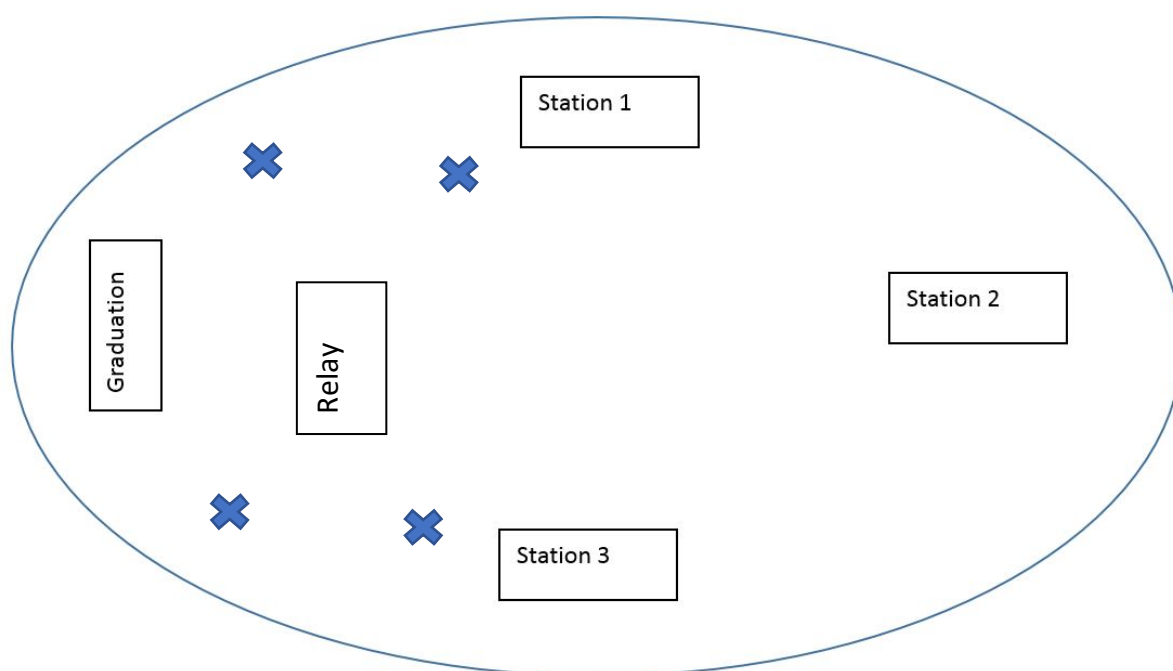
Ages: Young adults (18-25)

GOALS

- Goal & Objectives: OBJECTIVES
1. The goal of the facilitation is to communicate effectively with group members
 1. Given a wood block, the participants need to get across the block in the right order
 2. Given a paper and marker with string s attached, the participants need to draw the shape told to them in 3.5 minutes.

Risk Management Concerns:

Physical: While doing the block activity someone could possibly fall off the black and hurt themselves.
The facilitator should let everyone know the risks but should also have someone at that station to make sure everything goes smooth.

Mental: With the human knot activity it could be very weird to some people to hold hands with others they may not know very well.
The facilitator should give the option of having rope or something to hold on, so they don't have to be touching.

Address at least two potential and significant physical or mental risks that may occur during the facilitation. AND for each risk, explain how the leader should manage the risk (what should the facilitator do before and/or during the facilitation to decrease the risk).

Contingency Plan:

If the string on our markers for the "Marker Game" keeps falling off we could use duct tape instead of the string. The duct tape will hold better on the maker and still work the same as the string, so we would be able to successfully complete the facilitation.

1 minute	Facilitation Attention Getter (1 required)	Okay everyone who here has played Monopoly before? Cool, looks like just about everyone has at some point or another. Today we are going to play a few activities and move you guys around the monopoly board *points to layout of the gym* in hopes that everyone makes it to graduation. Your activities will be led by Gavin, Ema and Tyraina.	Will Dolk
1 minute	Facilitation Introduction (1 required)	We are going to play three different games today, marker game, jeopardy, and yardstick shuffle game which we will explain each here shortly. To be able to complete these games you must all be able to effectively communicate with your group members. That is the biggest thing for today, communication, hopefully you all can work together to complete each game and maybe make some new friends in the process. 3 minutes	Group Division (at least 1 required)	Instructions for facilitator to complete/set up prior to facilitation: Have our paper pieces cut out and in hand ready to pass out. Script: We are going to split you guys into three groups. Gavin, Tyraina and Ema will be passing out monopoly money. Once you have your money go ahead and find the rest of your group members for the activities. If you have Pink monopoly money you will be going to the red cone. If you receive green money, you will be heading to a green cone. If you receive blue money you need to find the blue cone.	Will Dolk
3 minutes 30 seconds	Activity 1	Name of the activity: The Marker Game Setup: the participants will need a piece of paper. A marker that is taped. Script: Hi everyone! My name is Tyraina and today we are going to test your communication skills. The activity that I have planned is called the marker game. Has anyone ever played this game before? If so could you raise your hand? Okay, perfect! The game looks somewhat simple. However, it's actually somewhat challenging. You are going to communicate with your group and write out ISU →, RRM (Reggie's Reclined Monopoly), KNR171. You will grab one string/ ducted taped end. Then you will communicate with your group members on how you want to go about writing the different acronyms and symbol. Remember you are not allowed to touch the marker. If you do well as a group and I am able to read what is written, then you will be given monopoly money. Please take your time and be patient! (Demonstrate) Does anyone have any questions? 3 minutes 30 seconds	Activity 2	Name of activity: Jeopardy Set up: participants will be gathered around so they are able to hear the questions Script: Hey guys I hope you have had success at the previous activities, my name is Gavin and in this next activity we're going to play jeopardy. I will be asking a range of questions about facts of ISU campus. After the question is read you are able to communicate with your group to see if you guys can come up with the correct answer, you will win monopoly money for each question you get right. 3 minutes 30 seconds	Activity 3	Name of activity: Yard Stick Shuffle Set up: Participants will stand next to each other on the yard sticks Script: Alright! Hi everyone, this activity is called the yardstick shuffle. In the other activities you use your verbal communication but for this station we will be using our non-verbal communication to complete our task. What I need you all to do is stand in a line on the yardsticks and I am going to give you a few variations of how to get in order and you all will have to figure out how to move along the yardstick without talking or falling off. You will have three tries to do this and if you make each variation in a specific time then you will get a specific amount of money. The times and amount of money you will receive are written out for you over here. (Point in the direction of the paper). Does anyone have any questions? Great, let's get started!	Ema Kolb
30 seconds	Transition into relay	Good Job Guys! Now that everyone has made it around Reggie's Recnited Monopoly board we are going to get ready for the relay. We are so close to graduation and I'm really proud of your guy's effort today!	Ema Kolb, Gavin Stauzone, Will Dolk, Tyraina Schupbach

5 minutes	Activity 4	Name of activity: Relay Setup: cones will be setup to show the boundaries of where participants need to run. Script: Alright! I hope everyone has had fun so far today making it around Reggie's Recnited monopoly board. We are so close to graduation! The last and final station today is the relay. Your group is going to compete against other the two other groups to see who will finish first. Everyone must go. This is how it will work. When we say Go, the first person will run down the gym around the cone, and back. They will then give a high five to the group member that is next. After everyone has gone we ask that you set down so that we can determine the winner of the relay. We will demonstrate right now what we mean. (demonstrations) The winner of the activity will get 100 dollars in monopoly money, the second place winner will get 50 dollars in monopoly money, and last place will receive 10 dollars in monopoly money.
